## SOUTH TARANAKI DISTRICT MUSEUM TRUST, PATEA

This compact museum provides invaluable access to heritage of the local area along with a research service and organised educational events.

The museum recently underwent a major new building project to allow for the installation of new exhibitions. Unfortunately a number of the museum's Maori carvings, weavings and painted panels were accidentally damaged during storage/transport.

The \$16,600 donation will be used to engage local Maori experts to restore the damaged artifacts in readiness for their final placement at the entrance to the new building. The Maori restoration team, according to tradition, will volunteer their expertise and time, accepting only a 'koha' or modest compensation for this work.
